To announce a direct competitive examination for the recruitment of 20 (twenty) personnel into the corps of Telecommunications Techniques civil servants, for the 2017 session.

THE MINISTER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORM,

Mindful of decree No. 75/783 of 18 December 1975 on the special rules and regulations of the corps of Telecommunications Techniques civil servants;

Mindful of decree No. 94/199 of 7 October 1994 on the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service, as amended and supplemented by decree No. 2000/287 of 12 October 2000;

Mindful of decree No. 2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government;

Mindful of decree No. 2011/410 of 9 December 2011 to form the Govern

ment:

Mindful of decree No. 2015/434 of 2 October 2015 to reshuffle the Government;

Mindful of decree No. 2012/537 of 19 November 2012 to organise the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;

Mindful of decree No. 2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to fix the General System of Government Competitive Examinations,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS.

<u>Article 1.- a)</u> A direct competitive examination to recruit personnel into the corps of Telecommunications Techniques civil servants have been announced. The number of available places for the various categories is distributed as follows:

- 5 (five) Telecommunications Engineers of the second grade of the 'A' category of the Public Service;
- 5 (five) Assistant Telecommunications Engineers of the first grade of the 'A' category of the Public Service;

10 (ten) Telecommunications Technicians of the first grade of the 'B' category
of the Public Service.

Article 2.- REQUIREMENTS

1. General requirements:

This examination shall be opened to all Cameroonians who fulfil the following conditions:

- a) Fulfil all the requirements for admission to a public service employment and conditions laid down by the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service:
- b) Be physically apt to assume the duties of Telecommunications Techniques;

- c) Be at least 17 and at most 34 years of age as at 1st January 2017 (be born between 01/01/1983 and 01/01/2000).
- 2. Specific requirements
- a- For candidates for admission into the corps of Telecommunications Engineer, be holder of a Diploma of Telecommunications Engineer or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.
- b- For candidates for admission into the corps of Assistant Telecommunications Engineer, be holder of a Diploma of Assistant Telecommunications Engineer or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.
- c- For candidates for admission into the corps of Telecommunications Technician, be holder of a Diploma of Telecommunications Technician or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.

Article 3.- FILE COMPOSITION

Candidates' complete application files shall be submitted; against a receipt, at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, Department of State Human Resources Development, Service for Direct Competitive Examinations and Scholarship (4th floor, Rooms 405 and 409) or in all Regional Delegations of the Public Service, latest Friday 20 October 2017. The files shall comprise the following documents:

- **1.** A registration form bearing a **CFA 1000 francs** fiscal stamp. The forms can be obtained from the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform or at all Regional Delegations of the Public Service or downloaded at the following website address: http://www.minfopra.gov.cm;
- 2. A certified true copy of birth certificate signed by a competent civil authority;
- 3. A certificate of non-conviction;
- 4. A certified true copy of the required certificate signed by a competent civil authority;
- **5.** An attestation of presentation of original of the required certificate signed by a competent civil authority;
- 6. A medical certificate issued by a public sector medical officer;
- 7. A receipt attesting payment of a registration fee of **CFA 15 000** francs (fifteen thousand) issued by either the Service Head for Direct Competitive Examinations and Scholarship at the Ministry or the Head of the Recruitment and Training Service at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;
- 8. 2 (two) passport-size photographs;
- 9. A CFA 500 francs stamped envelope bearing the candidate's address.

<u>N.B</u>:

- State employee candidates governed by the Labour Code who meet the conditions set out in Article 2 shall provide a copy of their contract or decision of employment.
- All incomplete or late files or files containing documents signed by the police shall be rejected.
- All documents should be certified by a competent civil, municipal or legal authorities and not more than 3 (three) months old.

Article 4.- SYLLABUS AND EXAMINATION TIMETABLE

- 1. The syllabus for this competitive examination shall be those of the training institutions that have issued the certificate required for application.
