ORDER No. 00 5 8 8 1 MINFOPRA OF 0 1 JUL 2019

To announce a direct competitive examination for the recruitment of 30 (thirty) personnel into the corps of Mines and Geology civil servants, for the 2019 session.

THE MINISTER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORM,

Mindful of the Constitution;

Mindful of decree No.75/786 of 18 December 1975 on the Special Rules and Regulations of the corps of Mines and Geology civil servants;

Mindful of decree No.94/199 of 7 October 1994 on the General Rules and Regulations of the Publical Service, as amended and supplemented by decree No.2000/287 of 12 October 2000;

Mindful of decree No.2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government, as amended and supplemented by decree No.2018/190 of 2 March 2018;

Mindful of decree No.2012/537 of 19 November 2012 to organize the Ministry of the Public Ser and Administrative Reform:

Mindful of decree No.2018/191 of 2 March 2018 to reshuffle the Government;

Mindful of decree No.2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to fix the General System of Competitive Examinations,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1.- a) A direct competitive examination to recruit personnel into the corps of Mines and Geology civil servants have been announced. The number of available places for the various categories is distributed as follows:

- 5 (five) Mines and Geology Engineers of the second grade of the "A" category of the Public Service:
- 10 (ten) Assistant Mines and Geology Engineers of the first grade of the "A" category of the Public Service;
- 15 (fifteen) Senior Mines and Geology Technicians of the second grade of the "B" category of the Public Service.

b) The written part of this examination shall take place on the 5 and 6 October 2019 in Yaounde, the only examination centre.

Article 2.- REQUIREMENTS.

1. General requirements:

This examination shall be opened to all Cameroonians who fulfil the following conditions:

- a) fulfil all the requirements for admission to a public service employment and conditions laid down by the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service;
- b) be physically apt to assume the duties of Mines and Geology;
- c) be at least 17 years of age and 34 years at most as, at 1st January 2019 (be born between 01/01/1985 and 01/01/2002).

2. Specific requirements

a – For candidates for admission into the corps of Mines and Geology Engineers, be holder of a Diploma of Mines and Geology Engineer or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.

- b For candidates for admission into the corps of Assistant Mines and Geology Engineers, be holder of a Diploma of Assistant Mines and Geology Engineer or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.
- c For candidates for admission into the corps of Senior Mines and Geology Technicians, be holder of a Diploma of Senior Mines and Geology Technician or a recognized equivalent diploma issued by a government national institution of training or by a recognized foreign or international institution of training approved by Prime Minister's order.

Article 3.- FILE COMPOSITION.

Candidates' complete application files shall be submitted, against a receipt, at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, Department of State Human Resources Development, Service for Direct Competitive Examinations and Scholarship (4th floor, Rooms 405 and 409) or in all Regional Delegations of the Public Service, latest Friday 20 September 2019. The files shall comprise the following documents:

- 1. A registration form bearing a CFA 1000 francs fiscal stamp. The forms can be obtained from the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform or at all Regional Delegations of the Public Service or downloaded at the following website address: http://www.minfopra.gov.cm;
- 2. A certified true copy of birth certificate signed by a competent civil athority;
- 3. A certificate of non-conviction;
- 4. A certified true copy of the required certificate signed by a comparent out authority;
- 5. An attestation of presentation of original of the required certifical signed by a competent civil authority;
- 6. A medical certificate issued by a public sector medical officer
- 7. A receipt attesting payment of a registration fee of CFA 15 000 francs (fifteen thousand) issued by an EXPRESS UNION official at the place of submission of the application files;
- 8. 2 (two) passport-size photographs;
- 9. A CFA 500 francs stamped envelope bearing the candidate's address

<u>N.B</u>:

- State employee candidates governed by the Labour Code who meet the conditions set out in Article 2 shall provide a copy of their contract or decision of employment.
- All incomplete or late files or files containing documents signed by the police shall be rejected.
- All documents should be certified by a competent civil trunicipal or legal authorities and not more than 3 (three) months old.

Article 4.- SYLLABUS AND EXAMINATION TIMETABLE

- 1. The syllabus for this competitive examination shall be those of the training institutions that have issued the certificate required for application.
- 2. The written part for candidates for recruitment shall be scheduled as follows:
