To announce a training competitive examination to recruit 20 (twenty) student Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PEPS) and 20 (twenty) student Assistant Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PAEPS) into the National Institute of Youths and Sports (NIYS) Yaounde for the 2019/2020 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORM.

Mindful of the Constitution:

Mindful of decree No.75/789 of 18 December 1975 to lay down the Special Rules and Regulations governing the corps of Youth and Sports civil servants;

- Mindful of decree No.94/199 of 7 October 1994 to lay down the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service, as amended and supplemented by decree No.2000/287 of 12 Octo
- Mindful of decree No.2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government, supplemented by decree No.2018/190 of 2 March 2018;
- Mindful of decree No.2012/537 of 19 November 2012 to organize the Min and Administrative Reform;

Mindful of decree No.2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to fix the General System Competitive Examinations.

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS RIME MUSCLE AND Some of the Second System, post-competitive examination to recruit 2000 second Article 1.- (1) A training competitive examination to recruit 20 (twenty) student Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PEPS) and 20 (twenty) student Assistant Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PAEPS) into the National Institute of Youths and Sports (NIYS) Yaounde is hereby announced for the unique Yaounde examination centre, for the 2019/2020 academic year.

(2) The physical part of this competitive examination shall take place on 6 and 7 August 2019 and the written part shall be conducted on 10 and 11 August 2019.

a) General conditions:

The examinations shall be open to all Cameroonians who meet the following conditions:

- 1. Fulfil the general requirements for employment into the Public Service as well as the conditions laid down by the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service.
- 2. Be physically fit to work as a Sports and Physical Education teacher.
- 3. Be at least 17 (seventeen) years of age and 31 (thirty-one) years at most, as at 1st January 2019 (be born between 01/01/1988 and 01/01/2002) for external candidates and 40 (forty) years of age at most, as at 1st January 2019 (be born between 01/01/1979 and 01/01/2002) for internal candidates.
- b) Specific conditions:

1 - For the admission into the cycle of Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PEPS)

- For external candidates, be holder of a Bachelor's degree (all options) or any other equivalent diploma issued by a recognised foreign university at the date of submission of file.
- For internal candidates, be Assistant Sports and Physical Education Tutor (PAEPS) with at least 3 (three) years of seniority as at 1st January 2019 or be a civil servant of the Armed Forces and Penitentiary Administration, fulfilling the same specific conditions required from external candidates and with at least 3 (three) years seniority as at 1st January 2019.

2- For admission into the cycle of Assistant Sports and Physical Education Tutors (PAEPS)

- For external candidates, be holder of the Baccalaureate diploma of General Secondary Education (all series) or the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE-A/L) in at least two papers excluding "religious knowledge" or any other recognized equivalent certificate.
- For internal candidates, be Senior Sports and Physical Education Teacher (MPEPS) with at least 3 (three) years of seniority as at 1st January 2019 or be a civil servant of the Armed Forces and Penitentiary Administration, fulfilling the same abacific conditions required from external candidates and with at least 3 (three Mears seriority as at 1st 1-27 JUN 2019 SERVICES DU January 2019.

Article 3.- FILE COMPOSITION

Candidates' complete files shall be submitted, again & a receipt, at the Ministry of the Department, of State Human Resources Public Service and Administrative Reform, Development, (4th floor, Rooms 405 and 409) or in all Regional Delegations of the Public Service, not later than Friday 26 July 2019. The files shall comprise the following documents:

- For External Candidates:

- 1. a registration form bearing a CFA 1000 francs fiscal stamp. The forms can be obtained at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform or all its Regional downloaded following website Delegations or the address: at http://www.minfopra.gov.cm;
- 2. a certified true copy of birth certificate signed by a competent civil authority.
- 3. a certificate of non-conviction;
- 4. a certified true copy of the required certificate signed by a competent civil authority;
- 5. an attestation of presentation of the original of the certificate signed by a competent civil authority;

- 6. a medical certificate issued by a public sector Medical Officer;
- 7. an information sheet duly legalized by a competent authority
- 8. a receipt attesting payment of the sum of CFA 15 000 (fifteen thousand) francs issued by an **EXPRESS UNION** official at the place of submission of the application files;
- 9. two passport-size photographs;
- 10. an envelope bearing a CFA 500 francs stamp and the candidate's address.

For internal candidates:

- 1. a registration form bearing a CFA 1 000 francs fiscal stamp. The forms can be obtained at the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform or all its Regional downloaded Delegations or at the following website address: http://www.minfopra.gov.cm;
- 2. a copy of the absorption or reclassification instrument;
- 3. a receipt attesting payment of the sum of CFA 20 000 (twenty thousand) francs issued by an EXPRESS UNION official at the place of submission of the application files;
- 4. an authorization to sit the examinations issued by the Minister of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, after prior approval of the minister under whom the candidate is working;
 5. an envelope bearing a CFA 500 francs stamp and the candidate and dress of the state of the stat

NB:

- out in Article 2 shall provide a copy of their contract or decision of employment.
- Incomplete or late files or files containing documents signed by the police shall not be accepted.
- All documents should be certified by a competent civil, municipal or legal authorities and not more than 3 (three) months old.

Article 5.- PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

Results of this competitive entrance examination shall be published through an instrument signed by the Minister of the Public Service and Administrative Reform.

<u>Article 6.-</u> (1) In addition to candidates finally declared successful in these competitive examinations, and in conformity with INJS adopting the Bachelor-Master's-Doctorate system, shall equally be admitted into the first year PEPS₁, the 1/3 of PAEPS₃, which are in the graduating classes of the first cycle of INJS.

(2) Admission of these students into the first year of $PEPS_1$ shall be done through an instrument signed by the Minister of the Public Service and Administrative Reform.

(3) a) In the absence of candidates from the Armed Forces, Police and Penitentiary Administration, the number of places reserved for the latter shall be allocated to civilian internal candidates.

b) In the absence of internal candidates or when there is not a quorum, the number of places reserved for the latter shall be allocated to external candidates.
