20-Subject

The Minister of the Public Service and Administrative Reform, Project Owner, hereby launches on behalf of Public Administration, an Open National Invitation to Tender on the Assistance to the project management for designing, developping and commissioning the new Computerized System for the Integrated Management of State Personnel and the Payroll (SIGIPES 2) specific to the State of Cameroon.

21-Description of Work

The consistency of the services covered by these Tender Documents is specified in the Terms of Reference, part No. 5

The services, subject of the contract, are divided as follows:

- > Elaboration of an implementation plan for the system;
- > Preparation of the organisational prerequisites and study of the regulations;
- > Assistance to the administration in the implementation of the system;
- > Monitoring the implementation of SIGIPES 2;
- Quality control of services;
- > Audit of the implementation of SIGIPES 2 (organisational, security, etc.);
- > Control of the supply, installation and configuration of the platform's various IT equipment;
- Periodic evaluation of the various works;
- Prior validation of each revenue;
- > Control of the integration of all the modules that make up SIGIPES 2.

The SIGIPES 2 configurations must allow its accessibility in both official languages, notably English and French.

22-Delivery Deadline

The maximum deadline for delivery provided by the Project Owner is 36 (thirty-six) months from the date of notification of the Service Order to start the work. It shall run from the date of notification of the Service Order to start the work.

23-Allotment

The services are in one single lot.

24-Estimated Cost

The estimated cost of services on the project management is FCFA 955 870 000 (nine hundred and fifty-five million eight hundred and seventy thousand).

25-Participation and Origin

Participation in this Invitation to Tender is open to all business companies involved in the commissioning of computer applications.

27-Bid Bond

Under penalty of rejection, the bidder shall submit together with his administrative documents, a bid bond amounting to FCFA 19 117 400 (Nineteen million one hundred and seventeen thousand four hundred), issued by a financial institution approved by MINFI and valid for 30 (thirty) days beyond the original date of validity of tenders.

31- Reception of Bids

Bids not in conformity to the method of separation of the administrative, technical and financial files or not containing the sealed witness financial bid shall lead to the disqualification of the file.

The other required administrative documents should be produced in original or certified copies by the service that has issued them or an administrative authority in conformity with the provisions of the Special Rules of the Invitation to Tender.

32- Opening of Bids

The opening of bids shall be done in two stages:

- The opening of administrative and technical documents shall be held first;
- Followed by the opening of financial bids that shall concern only bidders with the minimum required technical score.

The opening of administrative and technical documents shall be done on 20 MARS 2021 at 2p.m. (local time) in the conference room, 5th floor of the main building.

Only bidders or their duly authorized representatives can take part in this exercise.

The opening of financial bids shall be held at the end of the technical analysis and shall concern only bidders with the minimum technical score of **80 marks over 100**.

33- Evaluation Criteria

* Eliminatory criteria

- appearance on the list of enterprises suspended from public order;
- absence of a Declaration on oath of non-abandonment of the contract over the last 3 (three) years;
- false declaration, falsified documents;
- non-compliance of administrative documents after deadline of 48 hours;
- absence of the bid bond at the opening of the bids;
- lack of financial capacity:
- non-compliance of the Mission Head profile;
- absence of a quantified unit price in the estimate;
- presence of financial information in the administrative and technical bid;
- technical score below 80 marks.

* Essential Criteria

The scoring system of bids, which detail is given in the Special Rules of the Invitation to Tender, shall be done according to the following criteria:

34- Selection Method of the Consultant

The contract shall be awarded to the lowest bidder by summing the technical and financial criteria.

The formula for awarding marks is as follows:

The final mark (N) shall be awarded by summing technical marks (NT) and financial marks (NF), according to the following formula: $N = 0.8 \times NT + 0.2 \times NF$

The financial mark NF is obtained as follows:

Considering **Fm** the amount of the lowest bidder, his/her financial mark should not be more than 100 marks.

F is the amount of the bid under study

Other bidders' marks shall be awarded from NF of the lowest bidder, according to the following formula:

$$NF = Fm \times 100$$

F

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder with the highest mark.

Bidders shall be then classified by order of merit and according to the overall mark.

NOTE: Bids should be cross-checked and where necessary corrected. In the event of a disparity between the amount in figure and the amount in letters, the amount in letters will be considered. The amount of the bid will be therefore corrected. If the bidder does not agree with the correction, his/her bid shall be rejected.

35- Award of the Contract

The contract shall be awarded to the lowest bidder by summing the technical and financial criteria.

36- Commitment Deadline

Co-contractor shall remain bound by their bids within 120 (one hundred and twenty) days of the submission of tenders.
