To announce a competitive examination for the special recruitment of **40 (forty) auditors** from the 9<sup>th</sup> batch of the Institut de l'Economie et des Finances-Pôle Régional de Formation des Régies Financières de l'Afrique Centrale (IEF-PR), for the 2026/2027 academic year.

**THE MINISTER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORM,**

- Mindful of the Constitution ;
- Mindful of CEMAC Treaty of 16 March 1994 and its Addenda of 5 July 1996 and 25 April 2007;
- Mindful of Convention governing the Economic Union of Central African (UEAC);
- Mindful of Supplementary Act N°8/CEMAC-006-CCE-2 of 14 December 2000 on the list of Specialised Institutions of the Economic Union of Central Africa;
- Mindful of Decision of Ministers of the Franc Zone adopted on 13 February 1993 in Cotonou relating to the creation of two regional training centres;
- Mindful of Decision of the Ministers of the Franc Zone dated 4 January 1995 in Malabo on the creation of a training centre for Central African financial authorities within the Institut de l'Economie et des Finances (IEF) in Libreville, Gabon;
- Mindful of Recommendation No. 1/98-UEAC-556-CD-61 of 21 July 1998 on the training of financial management staff in the application of tax and customs reform;
- Mindful of Conclusion of the work of the 11th Ordinary Session of the Council of Ministers on 12 December 2002 on the practical arrangements for setting up the Institute;
- Mindful of Regulation No. 24/07-UEAC-IEF-CM-16 of 18 December 2007 creating the IEF-Regional Pole Diploma;;
- Mindful of Decree No 75/776 of 18 December 1975 on the special status of civil servants in the Financial Services and its various subsequent amendments;
- Mindful of Decree No.94/199 of 7 October 1994 to lay down the General Rules and Regulations of the Public Service, together with its subsequent amendments;
- Mindful of Decree No.2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government, as amended and supplemented by Decree No.2018/190 of 2 March 2018;
- Mindful of Decree No.2012/537 of 19 November 2012 to organize the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform;
- Mindful of Decree No.2018/191 of 2 March 2018 to reshuffle the Government;
- Mindful of Decree No.2000/696/PM of 13 September 2000 to lay down the general system of Government competitive examinations;
- Mindful of Order No.040/PM of 19 May 2022 to lay down terms and conditions for granting age exemption to persons with disabilities during government competitive examinations and recruitment into the Public Service,

**HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Article 1.- (1)** A competitive examination for the special recruitment of **40 (forty) Auditors** of the 9<sup>th</sup> batch of the Institut de l'Economie et des Finances-Pôle Régional de Formation des Régies Financières de l'Afrique Centrale (IEF-PR), is open for the 2026/2027 academic year.


**(2)** The places available are distributed as follows:

**(3)** Candidates will be able to choose their course of study at the time of submission of files.

**Article 2.-** The examination shall be open to persons who fulfil the following requirements:


- be of Cameroonian nationality;
- fulfil the general requirements for employment into the public service;
- be a holder of a Master's degree, a Master 1 or a degree awarded by a foreign university and recognised as equivalent by the Minister in charge of Higher Education in the following fields :
  - o economics;
  - o finance;
  - o management;
  - o administration;
  - o statistics;
  - o business studies;
  - o law;
  - o political science;
  - o Higher scientific schools;
  - o mathematics.
- be at least seventeen (17) years of age and 32 (thirty two) years of age at most, as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026;
- however, disabled persons holding a National Disability Card issued by the competent authorities may benefit from an age waiver for a maximum of 5 (five) years above the age limit set above, in accordance with Order no. 040/PM of 19 May 2022 referred to above.



**NB: This competitive examination is open to external candidates only. Civil servants in any category are not authorized to compete.**

**Article 3.- (1)** Registration forms can be obtained free of charge from the Regional Delegations of the Public Service and Administrative Reform or downloaded from the IEF-PR website at [www.ief-cemac.org](http://www.ief-cemac.org)

- (2) Registration fees is CFA 50 000 (Fifty thousands), non-refundable.
- (3) Candidates shall pay their registration fees in cash against receipt at IEF-PR No**30830052019** account open at ECOBANK-Cameroun. No other form of payment will be accepted.
- (4) Candidates shall submit their files upon presentation of at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform excluding
- (5) Application files shall be submitted at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of the Public Service and Administrative Reform not later than **Friday 6 March 2026 at 3:30p.m.**
- (6) Les The application files referred to in paragraph (5) above shall include the following documents:
  - a registration form bearing a CFA 1,500 franc fiscal stamp;
  - a certified true copy of the Baccalaureate certificate not less than 3 months;
  - a certified true copy of a birth certificate - handwritten or typed- signed by the competent administrative or council authorities;



- a certified true copy of the required certificate;
- a receipt showing proof of payment of registration fees for the competitive examination issued by ECOBANK-Cameroun ;
- an envelope bearing a CFA 1000 (one thousand) francs stamp;;
- an attestation of the presentation of the original of the required certificate signed by the Governor of the Region, the Senior Divisional Officer or the Divisional Officer;
- an attestation of presentation of the original of the Baccalaureate signed by the Governor of the Region, the Senior Divisional Officer or the Divisional Officer;
- a certificate of non-conviction of not more than 03 (three) months old by the date of submission of file and signed by the competent judicial authorities;
- a medical certificate of not more than 03 (three) months old by the date of submission of file and signed by a public sector medical practitioner;

**NB:** Any incomplete file or file containing forged or falsified documents shall be rejected.

(7) The list of candidates authorized to sit this competitive examination shall be posted at IEF-PR and on MINFOPRA digital platforms no later than **Wednesday 11 March 2026**.

**NB:** The publication of the list shall serve as individual notification to candidates.

(8) A radio and press release from the Minister for the Public Service and Administrative Reform will specify where the written parts will take place.

**Article 4.-** (1) The written part of the examination which shall take place **exclusively at the Yaoundé Centre on Saturday 14 March 2026** and shall be conducted according to the following schedule:


